|  | SATURDAYS | 5 hours a day between 7am and 7pm |
|  | SUNDAYS | Only 2 hours between 7am and 7pm |
|  | SCHOOL <br> HOLIDAYS | 5 hours a day on any weekday (except Sundays) between 7am and 7pm <br> but totals worked each week MUST NOT exceed 25 HOURS |
| WHEN I AM 15 and 16 | I CAN WORK ON | DURING THE FOLLOWING HOURS - |
|  | SCHOOLDAYS | Not more than a total of two hours in one day during the following periods: <br> (c) In the morning between 7am and 8am <br> (d) In the evening between close of school and 7 pm but totals worked each week MUST NOT exceed 12 hours |
|  | SATURDAYS | 8 hours a day between 7am and 7pm |
|  | SUNDAYS | Only 2 hours between 7am and 7pm |
|  | SCHOOL <br> HOLIDAYS | 8 hours a day on any weekday (except Sundays) between 7 am and 7pm <br> but totals worked each week MUST NOT exceed 35 HOURS |

## COMPULSORY SCHOOL AGE -

There is now a single date when young people can legally leave school and take a full-time job. A young person reaches the end of compulsory school age on the last Friday in June in the school year during which he/she becomes 16. When you reach 16, you will not require a work permit after the school leaving date.
