## Who?

**Who is your child with?**

Get to know contact details of your child's friends and their parents.

## Where?

**Do you know where your child goes in their spare time?**

Discuss with your child where and who with.

## What?

**Do you know what is going on for your child?**

Talk with your child about their life.

## When?

**When did you last check in with your child?**

Agree a curfew and contact your child and others if not home.

# Is your child going missing?

**Who to contact when your child is missing or planning on not returning home:**

- Contact the police on **101**
- Contact **999** if they are at risk of harm
