Is your child going missing?

A child whose whereabouts cannot be established will be considered missing until located, and their wellbeing or otherwise confirmed.

If your child is missing, have you thought about:

Brighter Futures for Children

Who?

Who is your child with?
Get to know contact details of your child's friends and their parents.

Where?

Do you know where your child goes in their spare time?
Discuss with your child where and who with.

What?

Do you know what is going on for your child?
Talk with your child about their life.

When?

When did you last check in with your child?
Agree a curfew and contact your child and others if not home.

Is your child going missing?

- Contact the police on 101
- Contact 999 if they are at risk of harm
