1. A 'looked after' child who is in LA care
2. A child with a sibling already in the school in the year in which they enter and who has a normal home address within the ecclesiastical parish of Christ Church, Reading.
3. A child with a sibling already in the school in the year in which they enter
4. A child with a normal home address within the ecclesiastical parish of Christ Church, Reading.

5. Denominational preference for a Church of England School, supported by evidence that a parent has been a regular worshipper (on at least one occasion in each of the calendar months in the previous calendar year preceding the date of the application) at Christ Church, Reading.
6. Denominational preference for a Church of England School, supported by evidence that a parent has been a regular worshipper (on at least one occasion in each of the calendar months in the previous calendar year preceding the date of the application) at a Church of England Church.
7. Denominational preference for a Church of England School, supported by evidence that a parent has been a regular worshipper (on at least one occasion in each of the calendar months in the previous calendar year preceding the date of the application) at any other Christian Church that is a member of Churches Together in Britain and Ireland.
