Winchmore Tutor's provides a tailored service that will meet the individual needs of your students.

Our tutors are all qualified teachers who have been through our stringent compliance process and have been hired for their experience and skills in working with students with a wide range of needs from special educational need, medical need and social, emotional, and mental health needs. Tuition takes place in a mutually agreeable location, which would be the student's home, local library or center or a room within a school where suitable.

Once a tutor has been confirmed to tutor a student, your account manager will arrange an initial set up meeting between the parent, student, tutor and referrer as well as any other suitable stakeholders which will outline how the tuition will work, the days and time tuition will be taking place, gather and essential information for all parties as well as providing a space for the student to ask questions and express feelings about the provision.

From the information provided from the referrer, set up meeting and that included in the students EHCP, the tutor will create an individual tuition plan which is added to the students' profile on our secure online system that can be accessed anytime by the referrer. The lesson summaries are updated weekly and the ITP's are updated regularly and reviewed half termly to ensure students are on track.

A half termly review will be arranged at the start of tuition which will include the parent/carer, student, tutor and referrer to look over the tuition, its success and any changes that might need to be

made. It is at this time that a students may want to increase hours or integration plans may want to be discussed along with any goals for the following half term.

Where students are integrated back in to a school or special setting, a re-integration meeting will be arranged with all stakeholders to discuss what this will look like and how this will work, as well as providing a space for the students to ask questions and explore changes. Tuition integration will work with the individual student but can include additional hours, changing hours to fit in with the start of the school day, moving tuition to a school location or in class support.

Where students require examinations, we can arrange and manage these such as GCSE examinations and Functional Skills qualifications at an additional fee.
