Additional Provision Information

TLC LIVE provide live interactive individualised tutoring sessions, delivered by fully qualified teachers to children in a collaborative, engaging format via our online learning programme. By delivering sessions online, the availability of tutors is assured, and the pool of resource available is much strengthened as tutors are recruited based on their ability rather than locality. With over 35,000 hours of national curriculum content available for children from 6 years old up to A level, we can accommodate a range of education needs. Contribution to outcomes Our service focuses on improving academic engagement and attainment by providing personalised one on-one support. As such, outcomes are geared towards removing barriers in education and supporting children to reengage in learning, ultimately leading to attainment of qualifications or entry back into mainstream school. Sessions delivered are designed to target skills gaps identified in the assessment, ultimately working towards larger outcomes such as improving academic ability and enhancing confidence through bespoke learning at a level the student is able to engage with. TLC LIVE recognise that many students out of school may need alternative pathways to help reintegrate into mainstream education or even just to pursue different academic pathways. That is why TLC LIVE are now a registered ASDAN centre offering short courses as well as an NCFE exam centre to allow delivery of Level 1 and 2 qualifications, functional skills examinations and our own mentoring programme.

How our provision works:

Individualised Provision: - Students are taught independently in separate online classrooms this helps them focus their time and energy on mastering the skills they need to catch up and move forward. Our baseline assessments help to identify the young persons current academic level and initial learning gaps. Further assessments are usually carried out every 10 lessons to track academic progress, this can be adapted to suit the requirements of the student or referrer. All lessons are run flexibly so while our tutors set out lesson plans, these can be amended during the lesson based on teacher and student feedback and interests.

Flexibility:- TLC LIVE can run lessons at anytime including weekend and holiday times, our hours are flexible to accommodate the young persons timetables so if we need to start a lesson at 10 past 10, we can. We can support anything from 1 hour up to 17 hours per week with no minimum booking. One of the factors Schools and Local Authorities choose our service is that we don't do contracts, so while you can book in a terms worth of sessions, as we invoice monthly, you only pay for the sessions that have been received, as we ask for is 24 hours to cancel or re-arrange a lesson.

Reporting and feedback:- At the end of each lesson, students are asked to give feedback on content and overall enjoyment. This feedback can be accessed by the referrer through summary reports available to download via our online portal. Our tutors will also provide feedback and summarise topics covered and a lesson plan for next time. Real-time attendance can also be viewed via our portal.

Quality of teaching:- Our live tutors are fully UK trained and qualified in their specialist subject so we can ensure each student receives the maximum support and guidance each lesson. All tutors are enhanced DBS checked for safeguarding purposes and all lessons are recorded and monitored through head office.

Process for Service Delivery

The service delivery process at TLC LIVE follows a structured 4-step approach to ensure that every student receives personalized support that effectively addresses their educational gaps and facilitates their academic progression.

 Planning Meeting: Upon receiving a referral, we organize a planning meeting with all stakeholders, including parents, educators, and any relevant support staff. This meeting aims to gain a comprehensive understanding of the student's needs, current educational levels, and desired outcomes. Based on this discussion, a personalized timetable is developed, and suitable tutors are assigned. This ensures that the student's learning journey is tailored specifically to their needs.

- 2. **Intensive Lessons:** Once the plan is in place, we commence with intensive lessons focused on bridging educational gaps and building the student's confidence. Our lessons are delivered flexibly, allowing students to engage in a comfortable environment, whether at school or at home. This stage includes 6-weekly review meetings where all stakeholders can assess progress, adjust plans, and ensure that the student is benefiting from the sessions.
- 3. Reintegration Phase: For students who are transitioning back to mainstream education, we gradually introduce TLC LIVE lessons on the school site. This step is crucial as it helps students reacclimate to the routine of attending school while maintaining the consistency of their learning. Lessons may take place in quieter settings like the library to ease this transition. Regular review meetings continue during this phase to monitor the student's progress and make necessary adjustments.
- 4. **Full Reintegration and Ongoing Support:** The final step involves the student's full reintegration into mainstream classes. To ensure they do not fall behind, we continue providing weekly tuition. This ongoing support helps solidify the skills they have gained and ensures they remain engaged and confident in their academic abilities.

Additional Services

While our primary focus is on academic subjects, TLC LIVE also offers a range of supplementary services to support the personal, social, and emotional development of students. These include careers guidance, CV writing, PSHE (Personal, Social, and Health Education), and mock exams. For students who benefit from a broader curriculum, we offer ASDAN courses, which cover less academic subjects like Foodwise, Health and Beauty, and Construction. These courses can be particularly engaging for students, providing them with valuable skills and helping them explore potential career pathways.

Pastoral Support at TLC LIVE

At TLC LIVE, we are dedicated to providing pastoral support that ensures the wellbeing of all students, including safeguarding their safety, promoting health and wellbeing, and offering tailored one-to-one support. Our approach is centred on creating a safe, engaging, and nurturing environment where every student can thrive academically and personally.

Safeguarding

Safeguarding is at the heart of our operations. All our tutors are fully trained in safeguarding practices and undergo enhanced DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) checks. We have robust policies in place to protect students during their lessons, whether online or in-person. These include clear communication protocols, secure digital platforms, and regular staff training to ensure that potential risks are identified and addressed swiftly. Our trauma-informed practices are particularly vital for

students who have faced challenging circumstances, providing a safe space for them to rebuild confidence and engage with their learning.

Health and Wellbeing

We recognise the significant impact that emotional and mental health can have on a student's ability to learn. Our curriculum includes PSHE (Personal, Social, and Health Education) sessions, designed to support students' broader wellbeing by teaching essential life skills, resilience, and self-awareness. For students who may benefit from alternative approaches, we also offer ASDAN courses such as *Foodwise* and *Health and Beauty*, which promote practical skills alongside emotional growth. Additionally, our tutors employ flexible teaching methods to ensure students remain comfortable and supported during lessons. Lessons are structured to build confidence, starting with achievable goals to foster a sense of success before progressing to more challenging tasks. This approach reduces anxiety and supports a positive attitude towards learning.

One-to-One Support

TLC LIVE provides personalised, one-to-one support tailored to each student's needs. From the initial planning stage, we gather detailed information about the student's interests, preferences, and learning requirements. This enables us to match students with suitable tutors and adapt lesson content to keep them engaged and motivated.

Students are encouraged to share feedback after every lesson, which our team monitors closely to identify areas for improvement. We also conduct regular review meetings with parents and other stakeholders to ensure the support remains aligned with the student's needs. This individualised approach ensures students feel heard, valued, and supported in both their academic and personal development.
