Young Giants is a specialist tuition service providing bespoke tuition and mentoring support packages for learners with a range of SEND (including complex needs/PMLD), neurodiversity, SEMH, those missing education, 6th day exclusions and those at risk of permanent exclusion.

We are a managed service (not a tuition agency), meaning we take full responsibility for the education services we provide. Our team of qualified teachers work on a caseload basis, forming part of the TAC for the learner and attending all support meeting for that learner. We ensure commissioners receive regular progress updates and attendance reports.

Based on the needs of the learner, our support takes the form of 1:1 tuition in homes, schools or venues within the community. Where possible and safe to do so, we afford the opportunity for peer interaction amongst our learners with a focus on school transitions.

Placing a strong focus on removing barriers to learning, our tuition incorporates the right amount of academic mentoring for the development of a Growth Mindset, positive behaviour for learning, academic confidence and personal ambition within the child.

We are an approved **ASDAN** centre, offering a range of 'preparation for adulthood' <u>pathway</u> <u>courses</u>. These courses are suitable for a wide range of learners including those with PMLD. We are also an approved **Arts Award centre** offering Arts Awards Bronze and Silver. These

awards, courses and qualifications have a significant impact on the academic confidence of our learners, supporting them to re-engage with education as a whole.

From Christmas 2023 we will be offering **Functional Skills exams** in-house, saving our learners from having to attend an outsourced exam centre to obtain their qualifications.
