someone if they need extra support, we make every student aware of this when they have their taster sessions and on their first day.

1. We have a maximum of five students per class. With smaller class sizes, relationships are built quickly; students feel closer to their tutor group and have the benefit of a greater adult-to-student ratio
2. All our team members are dedicated to providing a positive experience for each student, their parents, SENCOs and local authorities
3. We create an inclusive learning environment.
4. We use teaching methods that would engage and inspire students.
5. We have a great team of teaching/support staff who can give the time to students who are struggling.
6. Our environments are designed to be intimate, calm, quiet, with small student numbers to reduce noise and 'clutter'. They are designed with sensory needs in mind so the colours and lighting are tranquil and soothing.
7. Whilst we believe in certain standards of behaviour and some common 'rules', students are not tied to a behavioural system that will judge or risk creating a downward spiral of perceived negative self-worth
