Mellow Babies parenting programme

A 14-week group held once a week for mums with babies aged 12 weeks to 1.5 years. The coure aims to improve attachment and help you develop a strong relationship with your child.

Bumps and Babes

Join us for a pre-booked session with an experienced baby development worker enjoying activities to stimulate your baby's senses.

Rhyme and Song

Who doesn't love a sing song? Come and enjoy nursery rhymes and songs in a friendly group. It's a fun way to encourage speech and language skills.

Messy Play

Your young child, under 18 months old, will explore different textures and materials in a safe and friendly environment.

Stay and Play

A six-week course delivered in all Reading children's centres, to help children aged two with the first steps in getting ready for nursery. A great opportunity for your child to meet other children and learn through play. These sessions have a prompt start and require booking. Term-time only.
