### **Safeguarding**

Protect Duty May 2024 (Martyns Law Draft Bill– protecting public spaces). Consultation concluded March 2024.

Protect will be part of the government's Counter Terrorism Strategy, it aims to improve protection of the UK's publicly accessible places from terrorist attacks and ensure that businesses and organisations are prepared to deal with incidents. Apart from some sports grounds or on public transport, there are currently no requirements for organisations to take steps to prevent such incidents.

The Protect Duty legislation could change this, find out more here: https://www.protectuk.police.uk/martyns-law.

For some, the law could mean that they are covered by much of what they do already. For others, it will mean that understanding how vulnerable their venue or event is to an attack must become part of day to day business.

The primary qualifying conditions are for premises where:

- a. Their capacity is 100 or more individuals
- b. They are wholly or mainly used for one or more specified uses including Education and childcare

Action Counters Terrorism (ACT) for Education e-learning training

The training is aimed at staff working in education settings (Early Years through to the Further and Higher Education). Seven modules focus on embedding a security minded culture, identifying security vulnerabilities and suspicious activity and responding to incidents using core principles such as Run, Hide, Tell, the HOT Protocol and the power of hello.
