By law, every local authority (council), police force and other crime agencies must work in partnership to tackle community safety and serious violence issues in their local area. Over the last year we have invested in additional CCTV equipment and better lighting, improved safety for women at night-time and opened a new safe hub - the Reading Safe Space - in the town centre.
