The Secretary of State for Education <u>announced</u> that from next month state-funded primary schools will be invited to bid for capital funding to create or expand on-site nurseries. As is currently the case, these nurseries can be school-run or delivered by schools partnering with private and voluntary early years providers on school sites.
