

Admissions to Community Primary Schools 2025



Reading Borough Council is the admissions authority for its community schools. Places are allocated according to published oversubscription criteria as outlined on page 63 of the Guide for Parents and Carers 2025-2026. The table below shows the number of pupils offered a place at each school, by admissions category. Applications were considered equally, taking no account of preference order. In cases where a school was oversubscribed, a "tie-breaker" was applied. The tie-breaker initially prioritises those eligible for early years pupil premium (EYPP) and then ranks applicants by straight-line distance from home-to-school. The number of prioritised EYPP children and the home-to-distance of the last child offered* are both shown in brackets. The distance is measured in miles using RBC digital mapping software. *in cases where multiple children share the same home-to-school distance, the final place at a school is offered using random allocation.

Places were allocated according to the admissions policy of each school's governing body, as outlined on the relevant page of the *Guide for Parents and Carers* 2025-2026.

Oversubscribed schools apply a "tie-breaker" within each admissions category. In the case of Geoffrey Field Junior, the tie-breaker initially prioritises children eligible for early years pupil premium (EYPP) and then ranks applicants by straight-line home-to-school distance. For All Saints Junior, the tie-breaker is straight-line home-to-school distance only. Where a school is oversubscribed, the number of prioritised EYPP children and the home-to-distance of the last child offered are both shown in brackets.
