Become a Playworker

If you answered yes, consider a playwork position in a Reading setting and get your childcare career off to a great start.



What is playwork?

Many schools and organisations in Reading provide extended care for children before and after school and during school holidays. These clubs are structured to enhance children's development, health and wellbeing and include energetic activities and play opportunities.

What will I do?

You will work alongside a wider team to provide high quality provision for children up to the age of 16 years. Your role is to meet the needs of all children, develop relationships and to ensure a wide

range of exciting and engaging activities.

How do I progress?

You may wish to progress to leading a setting which involves additional responsibilities such as supervising staff, organising the routine and the smooth running of the setting.



What qualifications can I gain?
