- Support writing CVs and completing application forms.
- Supported internships, apprenticeships and traineeships.
- Applying for jobs, support at interviews, pre-employment checks and travel training.
- In-work support for you and your employer including help with reasonable adjustments, workplace assessments and compulsory training.
- Signposting to various services, such as Access to Work funding, benefits advice and relevant training.

Alternatively, If you are **already in work** and have a disability or other barrier and are struggling to manage with the demands of your role or you feel your employer is not treating you fairly, we can provide you and your employer with **support in your workplace**.
